It is mandatory to attend a driver orientation and get your car tech inspected before July 3th

Practice day Sunday June 27th

- 4:00 pm Track gate opens
- Registration for race and pay fees
- Set up pit lane box
- Fill out self tech inspection sheet
- Track official's tech inspection of cars and equipment
- 6:00pm Driver orientation class (Traffic flow, track direction, flags, driving instruction, passing, officials)
- 7:00 pm Track open for practice (6 cars at a time 10 minute sessions)
- 10:00 pm Track closes for practice
- 10:30pm Everyone out. Gates close.

Practice Wednesday July 30th Last chance

- 6:00 pm Track officials tech inspection
- 7:00/10PM Driver orientation class (Traffic flow, track direction, flags, driving instruction, passing, officials and practice)

Race day July 3rd

- 12:00 pit gate opens (pit spots are assigned in order of when registration was received)
- Sign in get wrist bands at registration building
- Unload race cars and set up pits
- Pill draw for starting position
- Camper parking opens. Reserve your spot
- Pre pay for gas
- 1:00 Final driver meeting in club house
- 2:00 Car show. Car, pit crew, and driver required to attend. Drivers need pen to sign autographs
- Voting for:
 - Ugliest car
 - Most likely to not finish
 - Most likely to win
 - Best theme
 - Best looking pit crew
- 3:00- 4:00 Carburetion hr final check of cars ability to run
- 4:00 Concession stand opens
- 4:45 Pre- grid opens
- 5:00 Fire safety staged
- Clubhouse opens for guard rail members
- 5:10 Pre-grid closes. If you are late you start in back
- 5:15 Warm up laps 3 laps slow. Helmets off wave to spectators
- 5:30 Introduction of drivers and crew. All drivers and crew members on required on the track with car in starting position
- 5:50 Prayer for the car by Reverend G. Anderson

- 5:55 National anthem
- 5:58 start your cars
- 6:00 Start of the race will be a standing, staggered start
- 8:00 Dance Music will begin
- 9:00 Campground bonfire starts

Warning no one under 18 years old will be admitted with out parent supervision.

Rules for Pit stops: Only people with pit pass are allowed on hot pit lane
 People with a pit pass are not allowed to drink. If you are finished driving for the night trade your pit pass for a spectator pass at registration
 Race car must stop for 5 minutes if it makes a pit stop
 Pit crew can only add 5 gals of fuel at each pit stop.
 Only 5 cars will be allowed in the hot pit lane at one time. If you pit and 5 cars are all ready in the pit you will be held at entrance to hot pit.
 Each Team (driver and pit crew) are required to have: a method to communicate while car is on the racetrack (e.g. cell phone, walkie-talkie, radio, signboard). A jack, jack stands or blocks in order to work under a car. Maximum of one 5 Gal gas can.

- 12:00 Dance music ends. Soft music on PA begins
 Concession stand closes
- 1:00 club house closes
- 6:00 Breakfast starts
- 9:00 breakfast ends
- 9:00 If there are any cars still running: race ends
- 9:05 Gather at podium for announcements of winners. (Fastest lap run, slowest last completed, car with most repairs during race, most laps)
