

Australian Pursuit Unlimited Road Race for Qualified Cars/Drivers  
October 17/18<sup>th</sup> 2009 starting at 10:00 AM-5PM

*Australian Pursuit Racing: A handicapped Road Race, which gives ALL participants a chance of glory. Weaker Drivers/Cars starting with a time advantage over the faster big guns where everyone has to work hard at this race of consistency. There's no room for sandbaggers in these races and anyone not running consistent laps will quickly be eliminated out of the back of the Pursuit. Watch out for the FAST guys, they'll be looking to catch you.*

*Qualifying Races are 4 Timed Laps of practice where your best time will be used to place you in the "B" Feature Pursuits.*

*"B" Feature Races are up to 6 cars running 5 Laps of competition where the slowest driver starts in the front of the Pursuit and the next slowest in second etc. Maximum slowest to fastest time will be one minute to organize each feature race. Racers will be spaced based on the 6 lap difference to help keep traffic flowing fast. You should never be passed in the Race if you run your dialed in time.*

*Consolation Races for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place finishers to created one last "B" Feature where one driver may move to "A" Feature.*

*"A" Feature will be the top finishing drivers (One or Two) from the "B" Features.*

*Passing will be allowed and slower drivers being overtaken will do a point by on their driver's side at the soonest safest opportunity and not be allowed to block faster vehicles. You may not hold up traffic to win during any lap. If you exceed your qualifying time in any lap of the race you will be black-flagged in corner 5 and disqualified from this race. No timing or electronic systems will be allowed in the cars as drivers must rely on their driving skills to not go to fast in any given lap.*

*Example Red Car qualifying time is 1:40 and Blue car is 1:45. In the Race the Blue car will get a 5 Second per lap head start. We will run 5 Lap races and do the spacing based on 6 laps so in theory no car will ever get passed in the race. The Blue car gets a 30-second head start. When each race is*

*finished we will add up each participants 5 laps to decide who was the most consistent and the finish order.*
